

# **Badminton Social Constitution**

## Aims of the organisation

1. The organisation shall be known as Badminton Social.
2. All members should encourage a friendly atmosphere.
3. We will aim to promote ourselves as a gay friendly club but open to all.
4. We shall provide and encourage social aspects to the organisation as well as badminton.

## Committee

1. The committee will consist of:
  1. Chairman
  2. Treasurer
  3. Social Coordinator
  4. Organisation Promoter
2. One person may take on more than one committee role.
3. The Chairman will be responsible for dealing with general running issues and coordinating other members of the committee.
4. The Treasurer will be responsible for dealing with the accounts of the organisation.
5. The Social Coordinator will deal with social aspects of the organisation such as organising events like competitions, meals, etc.
6. The Organisation Promoter is responsible for maintaining the website and advertising.
7. The committee will be informally decided amongst members and published on the website.
8. The serving committee's decision in any matter is final.

## Membership

1. Membership will be free.
2. A committee member has the right to refuse membership.
3. An existing member or new person wishing to become a member has the right to ask for a vote from the whole committee if they are refused membership. This vote is final.
4. A charge will be applied to members for playing at club nights and attending social events organised by this organisation.
5. Membership to the organisation will be assumed upon going to a club night and being accepted by a member of the committee.

## Club Nights

1. The club night will be every Monday night except bank holidays, between 8.00pm and 10.00pm at the Harvey Hadden Sports Centre.
2. Club nights will use a peg board selection criteria. The serving Committee will determine the rules of the Board and publish accordingly.

## Guests

1. Any member has the right to bring along guests to an event, unless the guest has been refused membership or the event is for members only.
2. A charge will be applied to guests for playing at club nights and attending social events organised by this organisation.
